

## LEXINGTON, CONCORD AND ACTON (WINTER 2021 SERVICE)

**7:20 AM** > Harrington School - Lexington, MA. (328 Lowell Street – Lexington, MA)

**7:40 AM** > Alcott House - Concord, MA. (399 Lexington Road – Concord, MA)

- Note: PM drop-off location is the Concord Mobil station located at Crosby's Corner (22 Concord Turnpike - Concord, MA).

**7:50 AM** > Paparazzi Restaurant – Concord, MA. (768 Elm Street – Concord, MA).

**7:55 AM** > Highrock Covenant Church (previously Makaha Restaurant) – Acton, MA. (257 Great Road – Acton, MA).

- Note: PM drop-off location is the Donelan's Supermarket directly opposite the AM pick-up (248 Great Road – Acton, MA).

### **PM Service (pick-up behind the dining hall)**

- In the afternoon, the bus follows the same-route, but in reverse. Modified drop-off locations have been noted above.
- TUE-TH: Afternoon departure from Lawrence Academy is 6:15 PM on Tuesday – Thursday.
- FRI: Afternoon departure from Lawrence Academy is 4:15 PM on Friday.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES AND INFORMATION

- **COST:** The following fee schedule is in place for the winter-term Concord/Lexington/Acton bus service.
  - Acton (High Rock Covenant Church): \$720 for winter-term service
  - Concord (Alcott House): \$720 for winter-term service
  - Concord (Paparazzi): \$720 for winter-term service
  - Lexington (Harrington School): \$820 for winter-term service
- **FIRST DAY/LAST DAY:** The first day of winter service is Tuesday, January 12<sup>th</sup>. The last day of winter service is Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup>.
- **NO SERVICE:** There is no bus service on Monday's (classes are remote).
- **WINTER WEATHER:** If there is a 1 or 2-hour delay to the start of school, then the above pick-up times will also be delayed by the same amount of time.
- **COVID EXPOSURE:** In the event that a student is exposed to the COVID-19 virus, the student may be required to undergo a quarantine process as a result of this exposure.
- **DE-DENSIFIED CAPACITY:** Service will follow a de-densified model. Students will sit in an assigned seat in an alternating pattern. Capacity will be set at one student per seat. Siblings will sit together.
- **HEALTH PRECAUTIONS:** Lawrence Academy will follow all Massachusetts guidelines for school transportation. Below are some of the steps that are being taken...
  - Passengers will be required to wear a face covering at all times.
  - Windows will be left in the open position at all times unless extreme weather conditions necessitate that they be closed. Dress warmly!
  - Buses will be cleaned after every service.
- **REFUNDS AND ADJUSTMENTS:**
  - If your child is required to quarantine and miss school due to possible COVID-19 exposure, you will not receive a refund for your transportation expenses.
  - If the Lexington/Concord/Acton/Andover bus service is cancelled for specific days or any portion of the term due to a COVID-19 health matter, you will receive a refund equal to approximately 25% of the daily fee for those days that are cancelled. This refund does not apply to holidays or long weekends.
  - Lawrence Academy cannot pro-rate the enrollment fee based on the days that your child is or is not attending school.
- **SPRING SERVICE:**
  - Similar to our approach this winter, you can expect communication from Lawrence Academy during the month of February in regards to our spring-term service.
